

**SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT FOR
ST. PAUL ELECTRICAL WORKERS REGULAR VACATION AND HOLIDAY TRUST**

This is a summary of the annual report of the ST. PAUL ELECTRICAL WORKERS REGULAR VACATION AND HOLIDAY TRUST (Employer Identification Number 41-6219001 Plan 505) for the plan year 10/01/20 through 09/30/21. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Basic Financial Statement

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$17,814,839 as of September 30, 2021 compared to \$18,879,217 as of October 1, 2020. During the plan year the plan experienced a decrease in its net assets of \$1,064,378. This decrease includes unrealized appreciation or depreciation in the value of plan assets; that is, the difference between the value of the plan's assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year, or the cost of assets acquired during the year. The plan had a total income of \$14,123,773 including income from investments of \$950,125, employer contributions of \$13,172,497 and other income of \$1,151. Plan expenses were \$15,188,151. These expenses included \$15,035,789 in benefits paid and \$152,362 in administrative expenses. A total of 1,308 persons were participants in or beneficiaries of the plan at the end of the plan year.
